


TRINITY 80 QT STAINLESS STEEL COOLER W/ SHELF Model # TXK-0802


You will need a Phillips screwdriver for assembly.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1


Align the HANDLES (F) on each side of the TUB (A). Attach the HANDLE (F) with the LARGE SCREW (G). Make sure to tighten securely. The HANDLES (F) can be attached either angled up or down based on your preference.





STEP 2

Turn the Cooler upside down, and align the LEG (D) with the holes on the bottom of the TUB (A). Attach the LEG (D) with the SMALL SCREWS (E). Make sure to tighten securely.


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 3

Align the holes in the SHELF (C) with the bottom of the LEG (D), making sure that the Shelf Lip is facing the TUB (A). Screw the LOCKING CASTER (K) into the bottom of the LEG (D), securing the SHELF (C) in between. Please make sure the LOCKING CASTERS (K) are installed on the same side. Screw the NON-LOCKING CASTER (L) into the bottom of the LEG (D) securing the SHELF (C) in between. Repeat for the other NON-LOCKING CASTER (L).

Tighten CASTERS (K, L) with the provided WRENCH (M).

<u>Use the provided caster wrench to tighten</u> <u>completely. Failure to do as instructed could</u> <u>result in the caster stem breaking.</u>




STEP 4

Turn the Cooler right side up.

Attach the BOTTLE OPENER (I) to the TUB (A) using SMALL SCREWS (E).

Attach the CAP CATCHER (H) to the TUB (A) by sliding it down on the metal notch.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5

Unscrew the DRAIN PLUG (J) assembly. Insert the DRAIN PLUG (J) through the opening in the TUB (A) from the inside. Make sure the rubber seal is on the **inside** of the TUB (A).


From the <u>outside</u>, slide the Washer on first, then the second Washer with Chain, and then screw on the Nut. Be sure not to overtighten. Once the DRAIN PLUG (J) is in place, screw on the Cap.



STEP 6

Set LID (B) on top of TUB (A).


Clean the inside of the Cooler thoroughly before use.

- 5. Check for damaged parts. Before using this product, carefully check that all parts are in good condition, and that the product will operate properly and perform its intended function. Check for damaged parts and any other conditions that may affect the operation of this product. Replace damaged or worn parts, and never use this product with a damaged part.
- 6. Do NOT let children climb or play in the tub or on the shelf.
- 7. Do NOT overload the product.

8. Lock the casters when leaving cooler in stationary position.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Do not use scouring pad for cleaning.
- Keep dry and avoid damp environments.
- Use a quality stainless steel cleaner and follow instructions that come with the cleaner.
 Wipe ALONG the grain (NOT against).
- Cooler should not be left out unprotected in the elements. A protective Cooler Cover (UBK-24-001-3519) is available as an accessory through <u>www.trinityii.com</u> website.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

TRINITY Stainless Steel Cooler Model # TXK-0802

Trinity International Industries ("Trinity") warrants to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the TRINITY Stainless Steel Cooler ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Trinity's obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at the option of Trinity, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Trinity and must be returned to Trinity.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than Trinity. The warranty period of 1 year shall not be extended or renewed by the repair or replacement of, or compensation for, the Product. Any warranty implied by applicable law is limited in duration to one year from the date of purchase and is subject to the same conditions and limitations as is provided for our express warranty.
